1.	Be on a clear-liquid diet all day Clear liquids are anything you can pour into a glass and see through. Liquids allowed are: coffee (black), tea, water, clear fruit juices (grape, apple, cranberry), bouillon, jello, soda, popsicles and Gatorade. (NO RED COLORING). No solid food, milk or milk products including non-dairy creamers. No food with seed or corn 3 days prior to procedure.	
2.	You will need to purchase 2 Dulcolax (bisacodyl) laxative pills and 1 bottle of MiraLax (238 gm), this is over-the-counter in the laxative section. You will also need 64 ounces of Gatorade.	
3.	ake the 2 Dulcolax (bisacodyl) pills at 3 p.m. on Mix the whole container of MiraLa ith 64 ounces of Gatorade. Start drinking the mix at 4 p.m. Drink one 8-ounce glass every 15-20 inutes. Be sure to drink ALL the solution.	
	WHAT TO EXPECT: After 3 hours of drinking prep, stools should be watery and water. If not, call Physician Exchange at (217) 222-2088.	you should be able to see through toilet
4.	You may continue with clear liquids until 4 hours prior to the procedure.	
5.	Since you will have a mild sedative the day of the procedure, you must be accompanied by someone who can drive you home after your procedure.	
6.	. You must <i>DISCONTINUE</i> the following medications 7 days ibuprofen, Nuprin, Advil, Aleve, any type of arthritis medica (NSAIDS), iron supplements, vitamins that contain iron, Ag as Plavix or Ticlid, and all herbal supplements.	tion, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
